### DUAL ENROLLMENT

Dual enrollment is a successful acceleration mechanism that allows high school students to pursue an advanced curriculum related to their post-secondary academic interest. Successful completion of dual enrollment courses allows eligible high school students to simultaneously earn high school core or elective credit and post-secondary credit toward an associate degree or a baccalaureate degree.
