DUAL ENROLLMENT

The APA-DE program is the enrollment of an eligible secondary student or home education student in a postsecondary course creditable toward high school completion and an associate or baccalaureate degree. A dual enrollment secondary student is a student who is enrolled in grades six through 12. Students would need to meet eligibility criteria for participation in the Dual Enrollment program.
